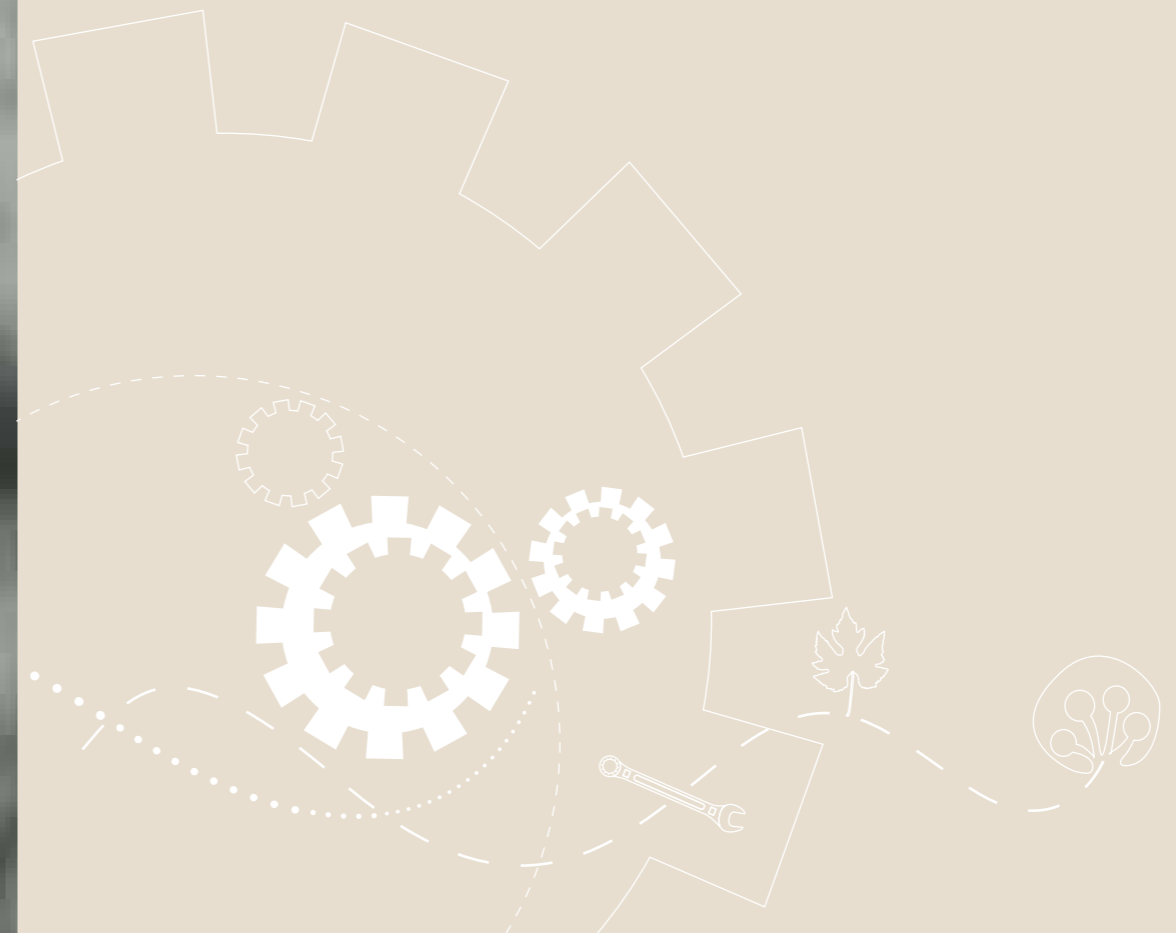




# Part-time

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## Part-time courses

Many students require a more flexible approach to study, one that can adapt to meet their changing circumstances as well as offering them a route to furthering their qualifications and enhancing their career prospects. People already working in the agri-food and rural industries undertake a part-time study route for a number of reasons;

- To develop an area of expertise
- To understand the wider operations within their company
- To bring themselves up-to-date with new developments and technologies
- To improve their career prospects.

The College's commitment to part-time study is demonstrated by the fact that all courses are available on a part-time basis, with flexible modes of delivery.

All courses are taught on a modular basis and industrial experience and prior qualifications of part-time students are taken into account. For some modules it may be possible to apply for Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL). Loughry also operates a Credit Accumulation Transfer Scheme for modular Degree programmes. This scheme is particularly attractive to mature students who have previous relevant experience.

A full list of the wide range of Honours Degrees, Foundation Degrees and Certificates of Higher Education, which are offered on a part-time basis courses is shown here, with the general entry requirements. Details of the specific entry requirements are provided in the appropriate course sections.
