STUDENT ACCOMMODATION CHARGES AND PAYMENTS 2020/21

The College of Agriculture, Food and Rural Enterprise has 350 student bedrooms across its three campus sites at Enniskillen, Greenmount and Loughry, with a range of accommodation types as follows;

Halls of residence (primarily for students under 18 years of age)

- Standard single rooms
- En-suite single rooms
- Twin rooms

Self-catered houses (for students over 18 years of age)

- Bungalow accommodation
- Student Village (Greenmount only)

The residential accommodation at each campus provides a friendly, caring environment, where you can mix with other students, pursue cultural and sporting interests, and enjoy yourself.

An offer of a place on a course does not mean you have an offer of a room in accommodation. You must therefore submit an online application for accommodation and you will receive a booking reference number. Bookings for accommodation for 2020/21 go live on the CAFRE website on the 1st June 2020.

Accommodation

All rooms in the Halls of residence - are offered on a catered package basis only. Accommodation is frequently oversubscribed and on such occasions room allocation will be based on the CAFRE Accommodation Allocation Policy, which can be viewed on the CAFRE website (www.cafre.ac.uk)

CAFRE Accommodation Charges for 2020/21 are as follows: -

All charges for accommodation (room only) will be invoiced by DAERA in late September and are payable within 30 days of receiving the invoice. The accommodation invoice will have an additional charge of £100 for an Accommodation Deposit, which is refundable at the end of the year as per the Student Licence Agreement Terms.

Catering Charges

For those students living in catered accommodation there is an additional payment for a catering package. This money will be pre-paid onto a 'cater card' on a monthly basis for use by the student in the college restaurants. The first payment of the catering package **must be paid on the day of course registration** by the student / parent / guardian in September. Subsequent payments must be paid by monthly Direct Debit or online at the beginning of each month. The first Direct Debit / Online payment will commence in October 2020 and the final Direct Debit / Online payment will be made in April 2021.

FAILURE TO PAY THE CATERING PACKAGE INSTALMENTS WILL RESULT IN THE CANCELLATION OF THE ACCOMMODATION CONTRACT AND THE STUDENT WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE ACCOMMODATION.

Catered Package Costs for 2020/21 are as follows: -

The catering package equates to £21 per week for students residing at Loughry and £32 per week for students residing at Greenmount or Enniskillen Campuses on full-time courses. Students whose accommodation requirements end early in Semester 2 e.g. due to work placement will have the later instalments adjusted to reflect this.

It is important to note that the catering package payment does not cover the full cost of a student's meals while living on campus five nights per week. The actual cost of meals purchased is deducted from each student's cater card and is determined by what they purchased. When the credit on the cater card is used up, students will have to pay cash at the tills for items they may wish to purchase or add additional funds to their cater card.
