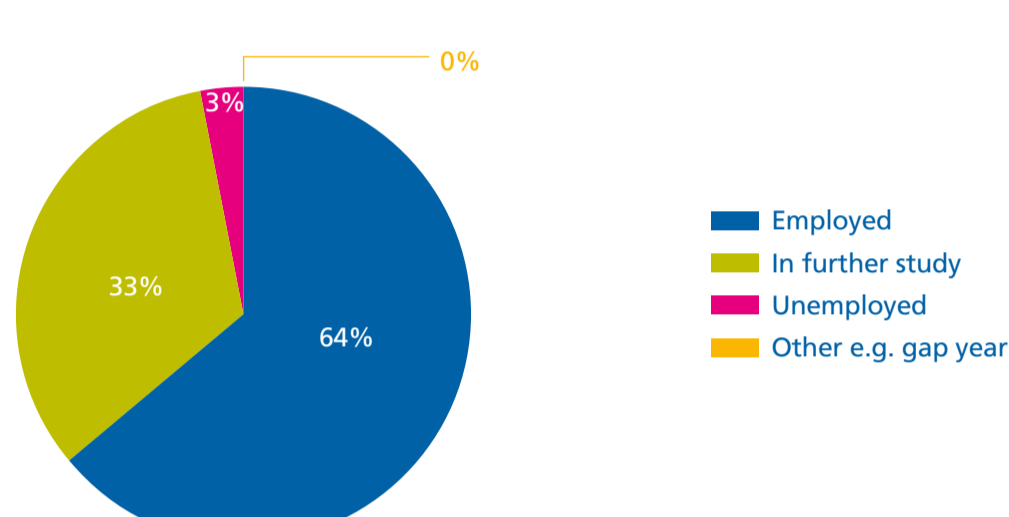

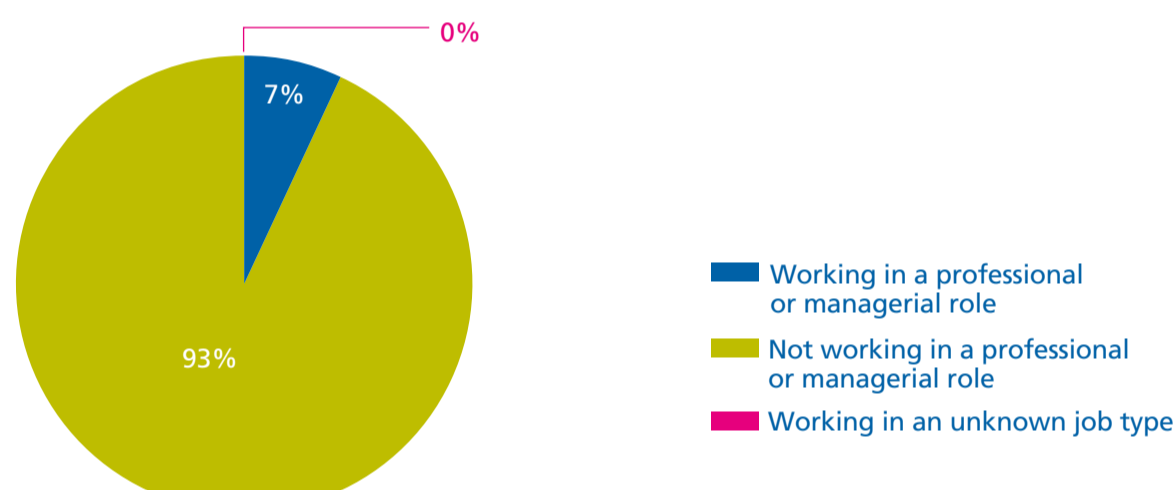

**£1,590** Typical annual cost of college accommodation

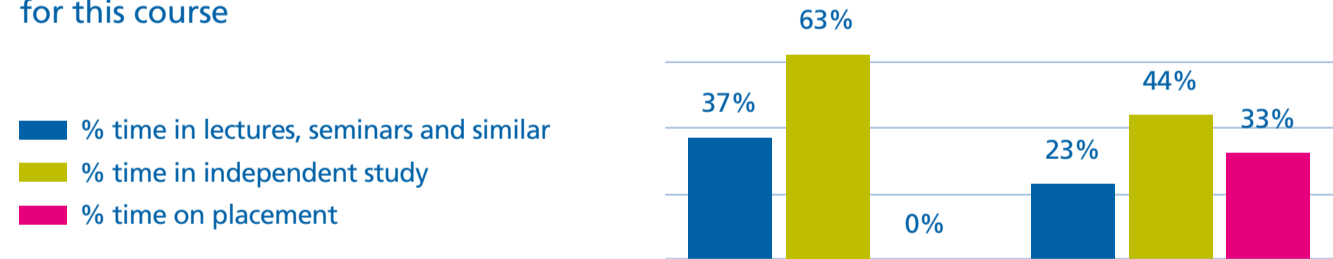
The accommodation cost is made up of £1,530 for room only, plus £60 recreational clubs and CAFRE Alumni charge

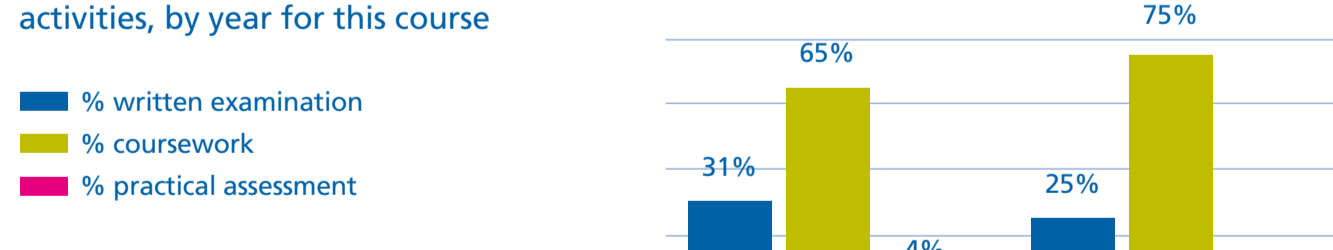
This is the percentage of time spent in different learning activities, by year for this course

**72%** Assessment by coursework

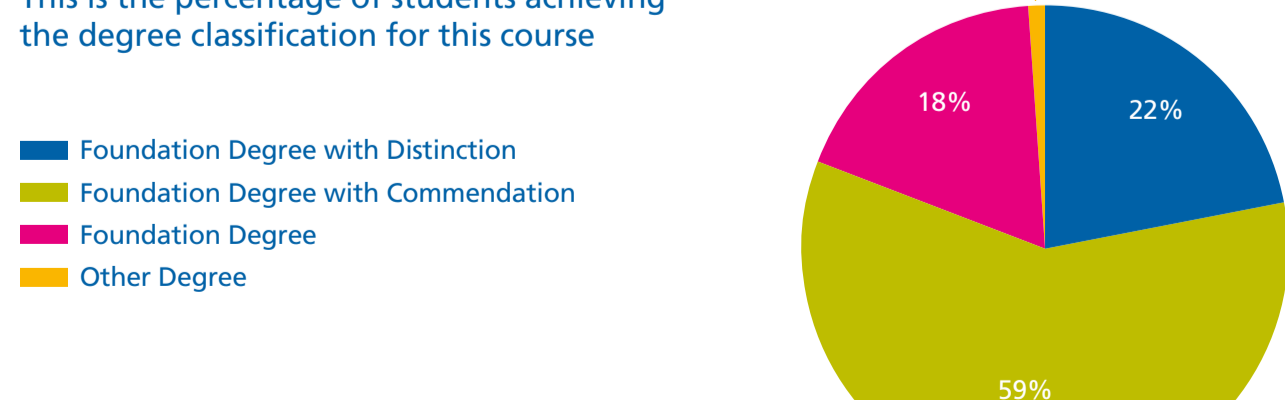
This is the percentage of assessment activities, by year for this course
