

SNHS Training Frequently Asked Questions

1. I have received my SNHS soil analysis report, what do I do now?

You should now complete the SNHS Nutrient Management Plan Training. You can register for training [here](#). From here, follow the instructions to register for training.

2. What details do I require to register for training?

To create an account for training you will need:

- Business ID
- Your name
- Address
- Email address
- Date Of Birth

3. How is training laid out?

Training is split into two phases. You must complete both phases to complete training. You must complete phase one before progressing to phase two.

Phase 1 provides you with an understanding of Nutrient Management. Phase 2 then uses this understanding to help you create a Nutrient Management Plan.

Phase 1 is completely online.

Upon completing phase 1 you have 3 options to complete phase 2:

Option 1: Complete phase 2 online using your training account.

Option 2: Visit [here](#) to register for and complete phase 2 training via an online webinar. This will be facilitated by Countryside Services.

Option 3: Visit [here](#) to register for and complete phase 2 training via face-to-face training. This will be facilitated by Countryside Services.

4. How long will it take to complete training?

Phase 1 training is a series of online videos and quizzes which will take approx. 1 hour and 30 minutes to complete.

Time taken to complete phase 2 online will vary depending on which content you watch, but will take at least 45 minutes.

You can complete online training over a number of sittings. When you log out, your progress will be saved. When you login again, you can pick up where you left off.

5. I don't have broadband or computer access. What do I do?

You can complete training in your local DAERA direct office. Contact your local DAERA direct office [here](#) to arrange training.

6. Do I have to do SNHS training?

We strongly encourage all participants in SNHS to participate in training. Training will allow you to make full use of your Soil analysis results and use them to create a Nutrient Management Plan, which will benefit your business and the environment.

7. Do I have to complete training all in one go?

No, you can save your progress and login again at a later time to complete training. Your progress will be saved. You will not have completed training until you fully complete Phase 1 and Phase 2.

8. Once started, do I have to complete training within a certain time period?

Training will be available for at least the duration of the scheme. Completing training as quickly as possible after you have received your results will have the greatest benefit.

9. Do I have to wait until I have received my SNHS soil report to do training?

Not necessarily. Training is available to anyone. However, it will be most relevant if you have received a SNHS soil analysis report.

10. How will training benefit me?

Training will give you the skills and understanding to create a Nutrient Management Plan (NMP). A NMP will help your business improve nutrient management, improving efficiency and protecting the environment. It will also increase your understanding of soil carbon and the measures you can take to increase carbon stocks on your farm.

11. What will be covered in training?

Training is designed to increase your level of understanding and knowledge of the principles of nutrient management, the role of carbon in soil and the interpretation your SNHS soil analysis report and maps. The training will also provide the skills you require to prepare a Nutrient Management Plan (NMP).

12. Can someone complete SNHS training on my behalf?

Training is intended to be completed by a member of the farm business. Numerous members of the business can complete training, but at least one person from each business should do so. Therefore, the attendee must be named on the DAERA business.
