Part-Time

The student fee for a part-time student undertaking a part-time course is calculated by taking the full-time fee for the course in question and multiplying it by the intensity of study.

For example, a full-time undergraduate Bachelor's degree student from Northern Ireland undertakes 120 credit points in the 2024/25 academic year that equates to a 100% intensity of study and pays a student fee of £4,750. A part-time undergraduate Bachelor's degree student from Northern Ireland may undertake 60 credit points in the 2024/25 academic year which equates to a 50% intensity of study of the full-time course equivalent and pays 50% of the full-time annual student fee for 2024/25 that equals £2,375.

The same formula will also apply to students receiving Accredited Prior Learning exemptions. Their fee will be adjusted to the amount of credits studied in the academic year.
