The Role

The role of Quality Assurance Assistant will involve assisting the Quality Manager with the implementation, monitoring and delivery of Quality Systems within a busy food manufacturing environment, ensuring the production of safe, quality products which adhere to quality, customer and legislative standards and specifications.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Assist the Quality Manager in the implementation and review of the site HACCP plan
- Conduct internal audits (Hygiene, GMP, GHP) ensuring compliance with agreed standards escalating issues to the Quality Manager & Senior Management
- Conducting & Verifying daily QC checks such as temperature, Brix Testing, Organoleptic testing, label and quality cross-referencing product specifications
- Raising and issuing Supplier and Site Non-Conformance records assisting investigations as required
- Completing daily / weekly checks, such as probe calibration and chemical concentrations
- Assist the Quality Manager with external audits (BRC, EHO, Customer etc), implementing corrective actions and root cause investigations as required
- Coordination of Pest Control, Customer, Supplier and third-party visits
- Maintain Quality Manual, Records and SOP's
- Implementing procedures and training staff through staff inductions and refresher training, including the training of staff in SOPs and Work Instructions
- Assist with the maintenance and administration of Operator training records, highlighting and escalating training needs in line with agreed SOP's
- Dealing with External & Internal Customer Complaints, investigating, reporting and escalating findings to the Quality Manager
- Issue and manage allocation of lockers, PPE and operator equipment to the floor
- Preparation of samples for external micro testing, recording and analysing results, reporting weekly and monthly trends and escalating concerns.
- Monitoring and verification daily of CCP's and general operational paperwork
- Assisting with traceability's
- Any other ad hoc duties as required
